EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

INTREPID confirms both liquid veterinary preparations and powdered xylazine are being used to adulterate fentanyl. INTREPID observed chemical markers in xylazine seizures that can assist in determining precursors. synthetic routes, and potentially connecting cases.





Examples of Materials Tested by INTREPID (source: DEA)


INTREPID found markers that link xylazine to repurposed veterinary preparations. In random, nonstatistical testing of 200 fentanyl samples (April 2023). INTREPID found that 84 contained xylazine. Of those 14 (17%) of them contained markers that link xylazine to veterinary preparations.
